Developmental Milestones

12 months

- Bangs two objects together
- Releases objects voluntarily
- Explores objects

18 months

- Turns over container to pour out Contents
- Spoon feeds
- Uses sippy cup
- Imitates housework

24 months

- Scribbles
- Builds tower of 4 or more blocks
- Helps with undressing
- Begins to sort shapes and colors
- Begins in make believe play

36 months

- Makes vertical and horizontal lines
- Scribbles circles
- Turns pages of book one at a time
- Builds tower of 6 or more blocks
- Undresses self
- Toilet training begins

48 months

- Copies squares
- Uses scissors
- Correctly names colors
- Understands concept of "same and "different"

60 months

- Copies triangles and other shapes
- Draws a person with a body
- Uses fork and spoon
- Cares for toileting needs

6 years

- Copies diamond
- Ties shoelaces without help
- Master buttons and fasteners
- Demonstrates strong desire to learn

7 years

- Able to organize multi-step sequences
- Proficient with paper and pencil tasks
- Can solve simple math problems
